



CHS Busing Information

- To qualify for busing a student **MUST** live more than 2.5 miles from the school (this is a state guideline).
- The computer system computes who is qualified using the home addresses in the data base.
- Qualified students will receive a letter prior to school opening. The letter will inform the student of the bus number, pick-up location, and time of pick-up. A number for transportation will be included.
- Students should arrive at the pick-up location 10 minutes prior to pick-up.
- Students cannot board another bus in a different location or pick-up their designated bus at a different pick-up spot.
- The bus driver and bus aide have a list of students assigned to each bus. This list will be used to validate bus use. After 2 weeks permanent passes will be issued.
- The bus is an extension of the classroom. Students are expected to behave in an acceptable/respectful manner.
- Inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated and will be reported for disciplinary consequences to be assigned.
- Students can be suspended from riding the school bus for a period of time. In some cases it is permanent for the remainder of the school year.
- All Buses are equipped with cameras and GPS.
- Public Transportation discount passes can be obtained from the South Wing Vice Principal Office.

Delayed opening:

- Students should arrive at their spot 90 minutes later than normal.

Special needs students:

- Parents will receive a permission form allowing their child to exit the school bus without assistance. If the form is not completed, the student cannot be released from their bus and will be returned to the school.
