

- I. Welcome:
 - a. Ms. Gaccione and Mrs. Carofine – Senior Class Advisors
 - b. Mrs. Rogers – Director of Graduation and Activities
 - c. Mrs. Slanina and Mrs. Maak – Yearbook Advisors

- II. First things first:
 - a. If you have not already done so, join the Senior Class Google Classroom
 - b. Type in the code: **mti14p**
 - c. Check back often (and pay attention to your notifications!) for updates, due dates, and info
 - d. You also have a cliffonschools G-Mail Account (same as your Google Log-in)...USE IT!!!

- III. Cost of Your Senior Year:
 - a. Class Dues (Class Day Presentations and Breakfast, Cap and Gown, Graduation/Diploma Photos, Diploma Covers, “It’s a Great Day To Be A Mustang” Shirt) = \$40 (due in February)
 - b. Senior Prom (June 20, The Legacy Castle) = \$110 per person (due late April)
 - c. Yearbook = \$80 until October 31st, then \$85 until May 1st

- IV. Funding Your Senior Year:
 - a. First Fundraiser: Selling Gertrude Hawk Chocolates
 - i. Catalog AND online sales – **ONLINE SALE GROUP NUMBER: 103834**
 - ii. Push the online sales (customers can receive shipments directly, and you will need to make no deliveries)
 - iii. Lowers the cost of Prom, Yearbook, and Class Dues
 - iv. **PROMOTE SELLING FROM OCTOBER 10-NOVEMBER 13. RETURN ALL CATALOG ORDERS TO MRS. Carofine (S116) AND/OR MS. GACCIONE (E214) BY TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 13!!!!**
 - v. Expected delivery: the week of December 10 – just in time for the holidays!
 - b. Second Fundraiser:
 - i. Mr. Cupcakes
 - ii. Each cupcake sells for \$2.50
 - iii. Profit of \$1.00 per cupcake
 - iv. Profits put directly toward seller’s dues
 - v. Sales run **1/14-1/30** for delivery in time for Valentine’s Day
 - c. Pay Attention for ALL fundraising updates
 - i. Last year’s fundraisers allowed us to lower both Class Dues and Prom by \$5 per person

- V. Life During Your Senior Year:
 - a. ANY category III (and excessive category II) suspensions/discipline infractions will remove you from ALL senior activities (Class Day, Prom, Field Graduation, Project Grad., etc). PLEASE DO NOT LET THAT HAPPEN TO YOU.
 - b. PASS YOUR CLASSES - We really don’t want to have to be the bearers of bad news when you are removed from a Senior Week activity to report that you are ineligible to graduate.
 - c. If you’ve noticed that your name and/or other information has been incorrect on your Schedules, Progress Reports, Report Cards, etc., please fill out the Diploma Correction form found on Google Classroom and the CHS Website. Your diploma is a legal document, so we want to make sure it is 100% accurate.
