This School Calendar is tentative, depending on weather conditions, and may be modified as required to provide a minimum of 180 days. If additional days are required, they will be taken from Spring Recess, beginning with Monday, **April 9, 2012**.

All dates listed in the calendar are inclusive. On the last day of school, schools will promote pupils, issue final report cards, and dismiss pupils at the end of a four-hour session. The remainder of the day will be devoted to teacher records and reports. Teachers may be dismissed at the option of the principal after all final records and reports have been completed and checked. Supervisory personnel are to be available after schools close for the summer vacation pending final school register check and until released.

Monday, June 25, 2012 is scheduled as the last day of school for the 2011-2012 school year. In the event of emergency closing due to storms or other unforeseen circumstances, the calendar will be amended correspondingly to provide at least the minimum days of pupil attendance required by law.

Personnel are to take into consideration the vagaries of the weather and other possible building closing emergencies that would require amendment of the school calendar. Personnel are not to schedule college courses, trips, or other activities which would be in conflict with the school calendar as adopted or should the calendar be amended. The legal opening of schools is September 1 and the closing of the school year is June 30. All 10-month certificated personnel can be required to render service during this period and are in a stand-by status on call if necessary.

Unused snow days will be returned as additional days off as follows:

Four unused snow days – **April 16, 2012** will be a school holiday as well as the Friday before and Tuesday after Memorial Day and Primary Election Day, June 5 will be school holidays.

Three unused snow days – **April 16, 2012** will be a school holiday as well as the Friday before and Tuesday after Memorial Day will be school holidays.

Two unused snow days – Friday before Memorial Day and the Tuesday after Memorial Day will be school holidays.

One unused snow day—Friday before Memorial Day will be a school holiday.
