Lacrosse (Boys) – finished 9-8 this year once again qualifying for the state tournament. Ten seniors gave everything they had to make this a successful year.

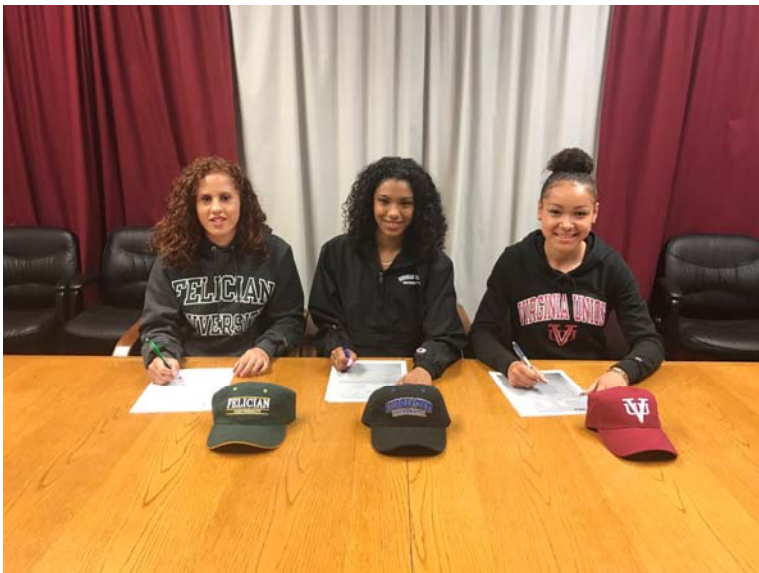
