Dear Parents/Students,

Reading is the cornerstone of a solid education brimming with possibilities. In an effort to encourage independent reading and accommodate individual learning styles, this summer, students **must** read **two titles** from the attached list, **one fiction and one non-fiction**.

The Clifton Language Arts Department in collaboration with the Clifton Public Library has revised the summer reading lists by grade level, incorporating a wide variety of enticing literary genres. Books borrowed from the library may be kept for twenty-one days. Students must have a library card and are responsible for returning the books on time.

Teachers will review the requirements for submitting the completed fiction and non-fiction novels, including the completion of one literature response assignment for each title read.

When returning to school on September 6, 2011, students are to turn in their completed literature response assignments (one for each book) to their Language Arts teachers, which will be used to assist students in taking an Accelerated Reader Quiz. Upon the completion of all requirements, the AR Quiz and the literature response assignments will count for one test and one classwork grade for the first marking period.

We strongly encourage students to read additional selections from the list to foster a life-long love of reading and invite them to wonder, imagine and explore life's endless possibilities. Should you have any questions about age-appropriate novels by favorite authors, please consult the librarians at the Clifton Public Library.

Kindly note that this information will also be posted on the Clifton Public School's web site, www.clifton.k12.nj.us. We, your partners in education, thank you in advance for your cooperation and support. Enjoy your summer!

LITERATURE-RESPONSE ASSIGNMENT LIST

Choose one assignment for each book read this summer.

Assignment #1

Directions: After you have read a selection from the Summer Reading List, respond to 4 of the 8 journal topics list below for each book. Keep your responses in a journal notebook, or type your responses on a computer.

Journal Topics:

1. Did you like this book? Why or why not? Would you read another book by this author? Why or why not?
2. Describe one problem or conflict in this story. How was it resolved?
3. What connections to your own life did you make while reading this book? Does the character remind you of yourself or of people you know? Does the problem in the story remind you of something that happened in your life?
4. What do the character's actions show you about his/her personality and interests?
5. If the author were here, what would say and ask him/her?
6. Describe the important ideas in the story. Describe the similarities and differences between the main character and you.
7. Explain what kind of reader would like this book most. Explain why somebody should or should not read this? How would you explain the plot of this story to somebody interested in reading it?
8. Choose 2 to 4 words from what you are reading that you had difficulty understanding. Interpret what you think each word means using context clues. Then, use a dictionary to locate the actual meaning.

Assignment #2

Directions: After you have read a selection from the Summer Reading List, rewrite the story as a picture book. Use simple vocabulary and illustrations so that it may be enjoyed by your classmates. (8 pages minimum – 10 pages maximum).

Assignment #3

Directions: After you have read a selection from the Summer Reading List, make a "Wanted" poster for one of the characters in the book. Include the following: (a) a drawing of the character, (b) a physical description of the character, (c) the characters deeds or misdeeds, (d) other important information about the character, and (e) the reward offered for the capture of the character.

Assignment #4

Directions: After you have read a selection from the Summer Reading List, create a dictionary containing 20 or more difficult words from the book. Include the word, a synonym and antonym, an icon (a picture), the word used in a sentence, the dictionary entry, and the word before and after it in the dictionary.
