What's on the agenda?

Students will explore a wide scope of careers ranging from science based jobs in medicine and engineering, law, law enforcement and first responders, to business avenues such as advertising and broadcasting, to trade school careers including mechanics, electricians, beauticians, to the culinary arts.

Emphasis will be placed on skills required to excel in these fields.

For example, a student who loves music will be exposed to the dozens of career opportunities associated with music even when he/she is not a professional musician that are viable and attainable careers.

Courses offered at both the high school and college level that will better prepare a student for a particular career will also be

explored.

The many different avenues of finding a job will also be a hot topic of discussion. No longer does a job seeker scour the classifieds, Today, there are dozens of on-line career opportunity websites designed to fit the qualifications of the applicant to the jobs available.

Ultimately, the members will create resumes and conduct mock interviews for entry level positions.
