# What Choices are Offered at I.S.E.E.?



Students develop artistic skills and techniques throughout the summer session.

\*Art can be taken from one to two hours.





Coding will be taken for one hour. The program will provide students with interactive and fun projects using basic coding and programming.

### Math

# Music Technology



Students in this course will have the opportunity to sample many kinds of music, learn the basic elements of music, develop a working vocabulary for discussing music, determine different qualities of music, and evaluate a composer or performer's choices with a composition as well as create their own, unique musical instruments using the latest technology and creativity.

\*Music Technology will be taken for one hour.

Students in grades **4th - 8th** get to choose 4 hours of classes!

Students entering 1st - 3rd grade will be automatically enrolled in a variety of classes including Music Technology and Art. Students will also work with their teacher on Math, ELA, and Science curriculum in a relaxed, creative and friendly atmosphere.
