








What Choices are Offered at I.S.E.E.?

<div>Art</div> <div></div> <div>Students develop artistic skills and techniques throughout the summer session. <i>*Art can be taken from one to two hours.</i></div>	<div>Coding</div> <div></div> <div>Coding will be taken for one hour. The program will provide students with interactive and fun projects using basic coding and programming. <i>*Coding will be taken for one hour and is open to students entering 4th or 5th grade</i></div>
<div>Math</div> <div></div> <div>Students participate in a hands-on, inquiry-based program that enriches their understanding of the mathematical concepts taught during the school year. <i>*Math will be taken for one hour.</i></div>	<div>Science</div> <div></div> <div>This program offers students the opportunity to become actively involved in science investigations in a variety of hands-on projects in a fun environment. <i>*Science will be taken for one hour.</i></div>
<div>Band & Strings</div> <div></div> <div>Students take both small group lessons and large group ensemble culminating with a concert on the last day of the program. <i>*Band or Strings will be taken for two hours and is open to students entering 4th - 8th grade.s.</i> <i>*Students must own/rent instruments.</i> <i>*Piano and guitar are NOT offered</i></div>	<div>Musical Theater</div> <div></div> <div>Students in grades four through eight put on a full-scale musical theater production that is performed on the last day of the program. This year's Musical will be Annie "Kids." <i>*Musical theater is open to students in grades 4th - 8th. Two hours are required!</i></div>
<div>Music Technology</div> <div></div> <div>Students in this course will have the opportunity to sample many kinds of music, learn the basic elements of music, develop a working vocabulary for discussing music, determine different qualities of music, and evaluate a composer or performer's choices with a composition as well as create their own, unique musical instruments using the latest technology and creativity. <i>*Music Technology will be taken for one hour.</i></div>	<div>Students in grades 4th - 8th get to choose 4 hours of classes!</div> <div>Students entering 1st - 3rd grade will be automatically enrolled in a variety of classes including Music Technology and Art. Students will also work with their teacher on Math, ELA, and Science curriculum in a relaxed, creative and friendly atmosphere.</div>

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS FOR ISEE:

FOOD AND SNACK INFORMATION:

- Students need to bring their own snack and a water bottle.

BUS INFORMATION:

- Bus will pick up at **Christopher Columbus Middle School** at 7:40 AM followed by pickup at **Woodrow Wilson Middle School** for transportation to CELA-S. Please be 10 minutes early.
- Return busing will transport students at 12:30 PM to WWMS, and then to CCMS and arrive there at approximately 12:40 - 12:50 PM depending on traffic.
- Bus does NOT make any stops between CCMS and WWMS.

CLASS CHOICES:

- For grades 1st - 3rd students will be given a variety of choices. Parents do not need to choose any classes.
- For grades 4th - 8th students need to pick the choices (for a total of **4 hours**).

INSTRUMENTS:

- BAND/STRINGS students MUST have their own instrument.
- Piano and guitar are NOT offered.
