2021 -2022 SMART GOALS

Smart Goal 1

Provide targeted instruction in reading literature, reading informational text and foundation skills in daily guided reading groups, resulting in an increase of +80 scaled score points for general population, +70 scaled score points for Special Education and +50 scaled score points for LE in the corresponding strands of the STAR Reading assessment from Fall to Spring.

Smart Goal 2

By June 2020, School 12 students will participate in standards based instruction and small group targeted interventions to increase mastery of the New Jersey Student Learning Standards in mathematics as measured by a 15% increase from placement test to post test for targeted subgroups.

Smart Goal 3


By June 2020, School 12 staff will research strategies and become knowledgeable on how student learning is being affected by social media and computer games. We will heighten parental awareness through workshops and community collaboration.

Smart Goal 4

By the end of cycle three of the Danielson Teachescape Evaluation mode, 80% of identified teachers will be rated effective or highly effective in Domain 3, as a result of UDL implementation, aligned to NJSLs, rigorous leveled and tiered differentiated stations in Language Arts and Math.

Clifton after-school program boosts students' 21st-century learning skills. For the second time, School 12 has received a \$2.5 million grant for a program to provide classes and after school care including a snack and dinner.
