 - September 1 December 31
 - Report Period 2
 - January 1 June 30

Student Safety Data System (SSDS)

- The Student Safety Data System (SSDS) collects two types of information from the schools/districts:
 - Incidents of Violence, Vandalism, Substance Abuse
 - Any other incident leading to student removal from school
 - Harassment, Intimidation, or Bullying (HIB)
 - HIB Trainings and Programs

Distinguishable Characteristic

 Race, color, religion, ancestry, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity and expression, or a mental, physical, or sensory disability

• Other

- Height, intelligence, and sports proficiency (Twp of Jefferson)
- Vegetarianism (Twp of Montgomery)
- Arachnophobia (City of Clifton)

Substantial Disruption

- Miss School/Class
- Decline in academic performance
- Change of routine to avoid offenders
- Changes in behavior
 - Withdrawn, Anxious, Aggressive
- Seeking adult support
 - School Counselor
- Disruptions at home
 Loss of appetite
